THE AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL CIRCLE WORK CHAMPIONSHIPS™ 2012 NORTHERN NSW HEAT COMPETITION RULES

Drivers

1. A current, valid Driver's Licence is required and must be produced.
2. Drivers must exhibit a zero alcohol reading immediately prior to the event. Testing will be conducted by Officials.
3. Seat belts must be properly adjusted and worn during competition.
4. Drivers shall wear suitable footwear during competition. Thongs or sandals are not permitted.
5. Passengers are not allowed in the ute unless required due to impairment such as hearing etc.. (Only the driver is to be in a competing vehicle).
6. Any ute failing to keep within the defined competition area whilst competing will be automatically disqualified. Any contact with hay bales will result in disqualification.
7. Both driver and passenger doors to be kept 'unlocked' during competition.
8. Competitors are not to have any part of their body protruding from the ute during competition. Failure to adhere to this rule will mean automatic disqualification.
9. Drivers will be asked to line up in competition order just outside of the competition arena and await further instruction from Officials.
10. Officials will give each driver a quick debrief before entering the arena, a horn will sound and the driver will start their circle work.
11. You will be required to stop after ONE MINUTE – When the horn sounds the competitor is to stop immediately and leave the arena at 5kph (walking pace), prior to the next competitor entering the arena.

Competition / Pit Area

1. No alcohol is permitted in the Competition Pit Area during the conduct of this event.
2. The maximum speed of vehicles within the Competition Pit Area is 5kph (walking speed).
3. All Officials must stay behind safety barriers during competition.
4. Official Photographers must stand behind safety barriers.
5. Qualified medical personnel must be on site and be in attendance.
6. NSW Rural Fire must be on site and in attendance with full knowledge of the competition.
7. Entry/Exit point into the Competition Area to be clearly marked.
8. Grounds will be wet down by the Officials before and between runs (as required) to eliminate dust.
9. The Circle Work Arena will be marked out using suitable materials.

Competition Vehicles

1. 4WD utes – **only stable 4WD utes with a low centre of gravity and standard radial tyres can compete.**
2. Utes must be registered with registration papers in the vehicle.
3. All utes will be checked for safety by Officials. **Anything that may be dislodged during competition must be removed, (anything loose in/on tray, tool boxes must be removed).**
4. Competition and demonstrations are restricted to one vehicle at a time.
5. The competing ute must have left the arena prior to the next ute entering.

Judging

1. The judge's decision is final.
2. The event will be judged on a ONE MINUTE run per ute by several independent judges.
3. Judges will award point as follows:
 - driving skills & level of control - out of 5
 - drifting skills - out of 5
 - number and execution of circles - equals score
 - number and execution of figure 8's - multiplied by two equals score
 - crowd reaction - out of 10
4. The judges will also look for competitors respect to public safety. For example, if you lose your bearings due to dust you will score better if you re-adjust your position rather than risking being disqualified from contention if you hit the event fencing/barrier.

1. Entries close **1pm on Saturday, March, 17, 2012**. All posted entries must be received by **Tuesday, March 13 2012**.
2. Successful entry into the competition does not automatically allow access into event. A Pass must be purchased.
3. All successful competition entrants must be available to begin competitions at the time specified by Country Capital Ute Muster organisers.
4. All utes must be registered and road worthy to enter the competition.
5. NSW Road Rules apply and will be enforced throughout the event.
6. Drivers will be breath tested prior to competing. A zero alcohol result will be required for a driver to compete.
7. Drivers assume full responsibility and accept full liability for their own health, well-being, safety, physical actions and the result of all their actions.
8. Country Capital Ute Muster event organisers reserve the right to vary the competition times.
9. The driver must complete and sign **every** applicable section of this entry form to be able to compete. Any incomplete forms submitted **will not** be accepted and driver will not be allowed to compete.
10. Utes must be registered as a utility and must have a tub or a tray (removable canopy allowed)
11. No passengers are allowed. This is a driver only event unless required due to impairment such as hearing etc.
12. All competitors will wear long sleeve shirts, long trousers and covered shoes. No thongs, shorts or t-shirts.
13. Seat belts must be worn and properly adjusted during competition.
14. Failure to comply with rules and parking instructions will result in automatic disqualification from the competition and forfeiture of entry fee.
15. The judge's decision is final.
